Wood (Acacia) — Mankind

White — Purity

Black — Sin

Red — Blood

Blue — Heavenly, authority

The Construction of the Tabernacle

The Base of the Tabernacle — Silver Sockets

The Posts — Silver tops

The Frames (or walls) of the Tabernacle – See-through and held together by rods. Wood overlaid with gold.

The Size of the Tabernacle

- The Structure Itself 45' X 15' X 15'
- The Holy Place $-30' \times 15' \times 15'$
- The Most Holy Place $-15' \times 15' \times 15'$

The Coverings of the Tabernacle

Layer #1 — Finely twisted linen with blue, purple and scarlet yarn and gold clasps

Layer #2 — Black; 18 inches wider than the other layers; Goat hair; bronze clasps

Layer #3 - Red; Ram skins;

Layer #4 — The waterproof layer. The hides of a sea cow, dugong or porpoise.
