Three Models of a Faithful Christ Follower:

1. The Key in the Model of the Soldier is Sacrifice.

"Suffer hardship with me as a good soldier of Christ Jesus. No soldier in active service entangles himself in the affairs of everyday life so that he may please the one who enlisted him to be a soldier." - 2 Timothy 2:3,4

A soldier sacrifices...

- The easy life ("Suffer hardship with me as a good soldier of Christ Jesus.")
- The secure life ("No soldier in active service entangles himself in the affairs of everyday life...")
- The independent life ("...so that he may please the one who enlisted him to be a soldier.")

2. The Key in the Model of the Athlete is Discipline.

"And also if anyone competes as an athlete, he does not win the prize unless he competes according to the rules." - 2 Timothy 2:5

- Discipline in training.
- Discipline in running.

God expects Faithful Christ Followers to be like the athlete who wins the prize—disciplined in training and disciplined in running!

3. The Key in the Model of the Farmer is Action.

"The hard-working farmer ought to be the first to receive his share of the crops." - 2 Timothy 2:6 A farmer's life is characterized by action — hard work!
