### **The Story:**

<sup>45</sup> From noon until three in the afternoon darkness came over all the land. About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, “Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?” (which means “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”) - Matthew 27:45,46

Charles Spurgeon entitled this scripture, “The Midnight in the Midday.” Here is the darkest hour Our Lord experienced, and in it we see two things:

### **The Pattern for the Saints**

*“To this you were called, because **Christ suffered** for you, **leaving you an example**, that you should follow in His steps.”* - 1 Peter 2:21

Two examples Jesus set for us as He suffered on the cross:

#### 1. Jesus always put others first.

*“You don’t know what you are asking,” Jesus said to them [James & John]. “Can you drink the cup I am going to drink?”*
