They killed none of them, but carried them off as they went on their way. <sup>3</sup> When David and his men reached Ziklag, they found it destroyed by fire and their wives and sons and daughters taken captive. <sup>4</sup> So David and his men wept aloud until they had no strength left to weep. <sup>5</sup> David's two wives had been captured—Ahinoam of Jezreel and Abigail, the widow of Nabal of Carmel. <sup>6</sup> David was greatly distressed because the men were talking of stoning him; each one was bitter in spirit because of his sons and daughters. **But David encouraged** himself in the LORD his God.

To encourage yourself in the Lord, like David did...

## 1. Call Out to God.

...and David inquired of the LORD, "Shall I pursue this raiding party? Will I overtake them?" "Pursue them," He answered. "You will certainly overtake them and succeed in the rescue." 1 Samuel 30:8

### a. In the process of calling out to God, talk to yourself.
