1. Blessed People

Happiness means:

"good fortune; pleasure; contentment; joy; delight." From "Happenchance and happenstance"

• Pleasure that comes from my circumstances.

Blessed means: (Μακαριοι, makarioi)

"consecrated; sacred; holy; divinely favoured; blissfully contented"

• God wants to give you an "inner island of contentedness"
