## **An Overview of the Book of Ephesians**

#### The Man - Paul and His Story

"Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God..."

- Ephesians 1:1

#### Paul was a Jewish kid from Turkey (Asia Minor).

"I am a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought up in this city. Under Gamaliel I was thoroughly trained in the law of our fathers and was just as zealous for God as any of you are today."

- Acts 22:3

#### Paul was an effective young zealot (persecutor).

"For you have heard of my previous way of life in Judaism, how intensely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it. <sup>14</sup>I was advancing in Judaism beyond many Jews of my own age and was extremely zealous for the traditions of my fathers." – Galatians 1:13

#### Paul had a dramatic conversion story!

"But when God, who set me apart from birth and called me by His grace, was pleased <sup>16</sup>to reveal His Son in me so that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not consult any man..."

- Galatians 1:15,16

"About noon as I came near Damascus, suddenly a bright light from heaven flashed around me. <sup>7</sup>I fell to the ground and heard a voice say to me, 'Sau!! Sau!! Why do you persecute me?' <sup>8</sup>" Who are you, Lord?' I asked. "'I am Jesus of Nazareth, whom you are persecuting,' He replied. <sup>9</sup>My companions saw the light, but they did not understand the voice of Him who was speaking to me. <sup>10</sup>" What shall I do, Lord?' I asked."- Acts 22:6-10

#### Paul was an apostle to the Gentiles and he traveled the world.

"Then Paul and Barnabas answered them boldly: "We had to speak the word of God to you first. Since you reject it and do not consider yourselves worthy of eternal life, we now turn to the Gentiles. <sup>47</sup>For this is what the Lord has commanded us: "I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth." - Acts 13:46.47



### Paul was a citizen of Rome who was persecuted for his faith.

"For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles..." - Eph. 3:1 "For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time has come for my departure. <sup>7</sup>I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith." - 2 Timothy 4:6,7

"To the saints in Ephesus, the faithful in Christ Jesus..." - Ephesians 1:1 Paul wrote to Christians who were discipled and were his personal friends.

#### The Time of Writing

Probably written about 62 AD from prison in Rome.



#### The Place -- Ephesus

A capital city of the Roman empire (province of Asia).

A place Paul lived longer than anywhere in his Christian life.

- He witnessed here on his second missionary journey.
  - "They arrived at Ephesus, where Paul left Priscilla and Aquila. He himself went into the synagogue and reasoned with the Jews." Acts 18:19
- He stayed here 3 years on his third missionary journey.
  - "So be on your guard! Remember that for three years I never stopped warning each of you night and day with tears." Acts 20:31
- During this time there was a Holy Spirit filling for the followers of John the Baptist; and a riot over the goddess, Artemis. (Notable people who lived here were Priscilla, Aquila, and Apollos.)
- Later, Timothy became the pastor of this church.

### **The Purpose**

- 1. To encourage Christians to walk (live) differently: to understand their identity in Christ. (chapters 1-3)
- 2. To encourage Christians to stop acting childishly and selfishly. (chapter 4)
- 3. To encourage Christians to live righteously, particularly within family relationships. (chapter 5-6)
- 4. To encourage Christians to "dress for battle." (chapter 6)
