Why Do We See Jesus as King?

- 1. He had the genealogy of a king.
 - "A record of the genealogy of Jesus Christ **the son of David**, the son of Abraham..."
 Matthew 1:1
- 2. He was called a king by the prophets.
 - "Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end. **He will reign on David's throne** and over his **kingdom**, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever..."

 Isaiah 9:6,7
- 3. He was called a king at His birth.
 - "...and asked, "Where is the one who has been born **king of the Jews**? We saw his star in the east and have come to worship Him." Matthew 2:2
- 4. He was called a king by the angels.
 - "He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give

Him the throne of His father David, ³³ and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever; His kingdom will never end." - Luke 1:32,33

- 5. He was called a king by those that mocked Him.
