EXPECTANT WAITING: ADVENT DEVOTIONAL



Lord, we know we are in darkness unless the light of Your son, Jesus, shines in our hearts. It is often easier to remain in our darkness, sin, and shame, but we desire to be filled with Your love, the love that sets us free. REFLECT

QUESTION

How might God be shining the light of His love in your heart this Advent season? How might you respond?
