1. The Authority of Scripture

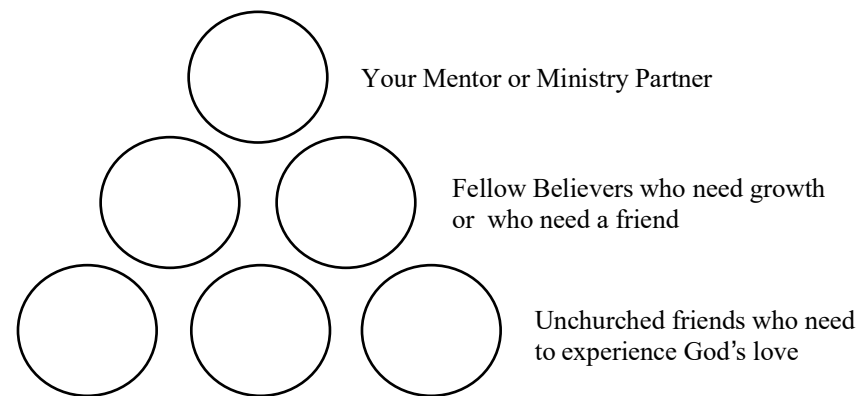
