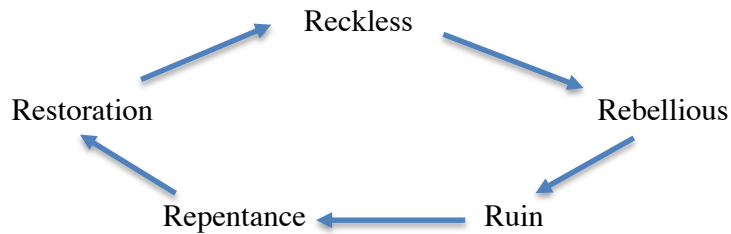


What Happens When We See God?

Why Do We Fail To See God Clearly?

1. We rebel against God.
 - Sin = Willful disobedience to the known will of God.

2. We put God in a box.
 - God is bigger than all of our boxes! (2 Kings 5:10-15)
3. We see God through ourselves.
 - When we see God through ourselves, two major problems arise:
 - a. We don't see a balanced God.
 - b. We see God in our exclusive way.

6. We become apathetic.

What Happens When We See God Clearly?

1. Confusion/chaos - causes us to seek God.

2. Confession

3. Change

"Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!" - Isaiah 6:8

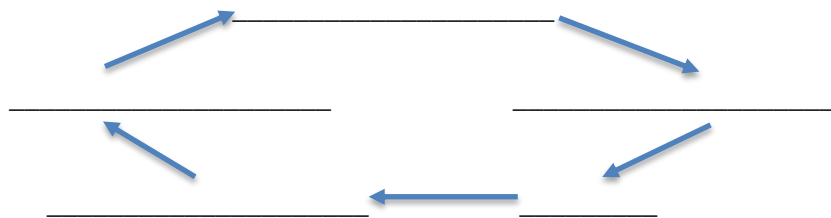
