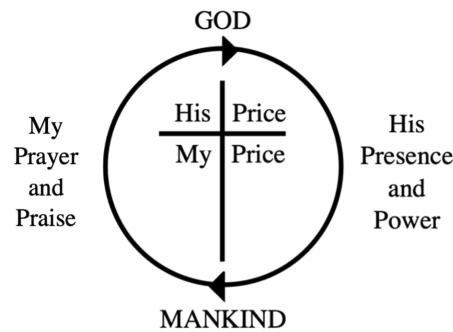


Relational Experiences With God

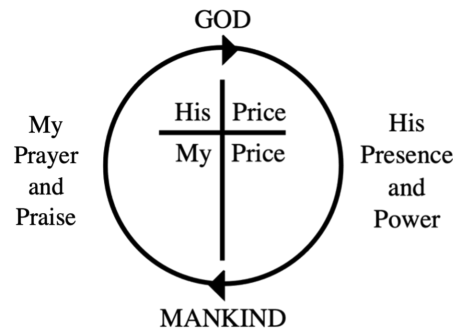
