
1 John 3:2,3You Asked For It!Week 2Certainties of the Second Coming

The Lord will come and take His children away.

The Latin word used for this event is "rapture".

"For the Lord Himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ After that, we who are still alive and are left will be **caught up** together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever." - 1 Thessalonians 4:16,17

"Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—⁵² in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. ⁵³ For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality."

There are three Greek words that tell of Jesus' coming:

- 1. $\pi\alpha\rho\sigma\sigma\alpha$ (Parousia) 24 times in the New Testament. "coming"
- 2. $\phi \alpha \nu \epsilon \rho \omega \omega$ (Phanerow) brightness, splendour.

3. αποκαλυπσισ (Apocalupsis) – "disclosure" "revealing" unveiling of Jesus

3. Religious control. (Revelation 13:15)


