When Jesus returns in all of His glory, everyone will stand before Him. This includes Christians, non-Christians and even Satan.

We can be certain that...

All People Will Stand Before Christ & Give an Account

There will be two judgments. One for salvation and one for deeds.

When is a Christian judged for their salvation, their eternal destiny?

• When they repent and ask Jesus for forgiveness.

"Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."

- Romans 8:1

- 1 Peter 4:10

When is a non-believer judged for their eternal destiny?

• When they die.

"...people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment."- Hebrews 9:27

The "works/deeds" of Christians will be judged at the Judgment Seat of Christ.

"For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ. ¹² If anyone builds on this foundation using **gold**, **silver**, **costly stones**, wood, hay or straw, ¹³ their work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each person's work. ¹⁴ If what has been built survives, the builder will receive a reward. ¹⁵ If it is burned up, the builder will suffer loss but yet will be saved—even though only as one escaping through the flames." -1 Corinthians 3:11-15

- 3. The Crown of Rejoicing rejoicing that others have found Jesus "For what is our hope, our joy, or the crown in which we will glory in the presence of our Lord Jesus when He comes? Is it not you?" -1 Thess. 2:19
- 4. The Crown of Glory for watching over and caring for people "Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, watching over them—not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not pursuing dishonest gain, but eager to serve; ³ not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock. ⁴ And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away."
