"Be very careful, then, how you live — not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is. God's Will is Divided into Two Parts:

1. His Determined Will (His "Will of Purpose") — Eph. 1:3-12

2. His Desired Will (His "Will of Passion") — Eph. 5:15-21

God's Determined Will

2. Limited/Temporal

3. It will occur

3. It may or may not happen

4. Cannot be frustrated

4. Can be resisted

How does God make His will known?

- 1. Peace "inner peace" (cf. Romans 14 "being fully convinced")

 "Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts" Colossians 3:15
- 2. Satisfaction "inner joy"

How to Experience the PEACE of God's will:

- P Present yourself completely to Him. (Romans 12:1,2)
- E Examine your motives before Him.
- A Accept all of your direction from Him.
- C Choose continually to obey Him.
- E Experience the joy of walking with Him.
