Why is Lordship Necessary?

Lordship settles the <u>position</u> issue. (Who is #1 in my life?)

Pride is the oldest sin in the universe and shows no sign of weakening with age.

Jesus was not "position conscious" because He knew ... (John 13:3ff)

- A. What He <u>possessed</u>.
- B. Who He was.
- C. Where He was going.

God is to be Lord in our ...

1. Salvation (Romans 10:9)

"If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in you heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved." - Romans 10:9

2. Everyday Life (Colossians 3:23)

"Whatever you do, do your work heartily, **as for the Lord** rather than for men."
- Colossians 3:23

3. Busyness (Romans 12:11)

"Not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord."

- Romans 12:11

4. Family (Ephesians 5:21,22,25)

"Submit to one another **out of reverence for Christ**."

"A wife should put her husband first, as she does the Lord."

"A husband should love his wife **as much as Christ loved the church** and gave His life for it." - Eph. 5:21,22,25 (CEV)

Lordship settles the <u>permission</u> issue. (Who has the right to my life?)

"As they were walking along the road, a man said to Him, "I will follow you wherever you go." ⁵⁸Jesus replied, "Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay His head." ⁵⁹He said to another man, "Follow me." But the man replied, "Lord, first let me go and bury my father." ⁶⁰Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and proclaim the kingdom of God." ⁶¹Still another said, "I will follow you, Lord; but first let me go back and say goodbye to my family." ⁶²Jesus replied, "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God." - Luke 9:57-62


- A. Accepting the future regardless of the cost. (vs. 57-58)


