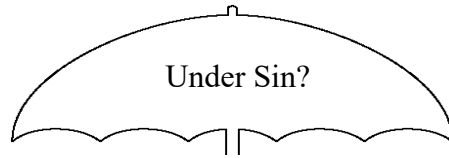

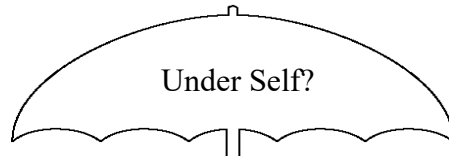

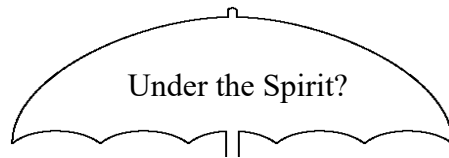

The Crucified Life is:

1. Personal — (not corporate) "**I** have been crucified with Christ..."
2. Identifiable —

- a. Both give victory over the sin problem.
- b. Both are the Father's will.
- c. Both advance the Kingdom of God.
- d. Both are difficult.
- e. Both lead to a resurrection.
- f. Both glorify God.

3. Total — "...and I no longer live..."

"The closer we get to the cross, the more we are aware of self within us."

4. Beautiful — "*Christ lives in me!*"

5. Present Tense — "*The life I **now** live...*"

6. Victorious Life — "*I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me!*"

- b. It's faith instead of feeling.
- c. It's now instead of then.

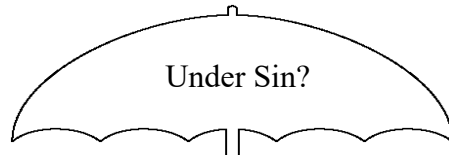
The results of this victorious, crucified life: (Colossians 3:15-16)

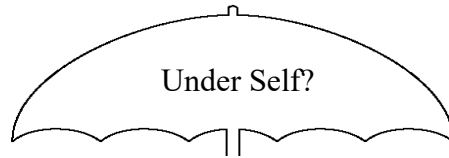

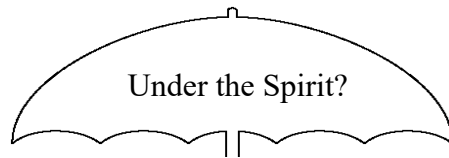
