“How Do I Lead When I’m Still Learning?”

Key Truth: You do not have to know everything about God to help someone follow Him. You just have to keep walking toward Jesus yourself.

1. God Designed Faith to Be Passed Down, Not Perfected First

“Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road...” Deuteronomy 6:6-7

Discipleship happens in motion.

God uses us while we're still learning.

People don't need spiritual superheroes who have arrived. They need people who are honestly walking with Jesus.

2. Authentic Faith Matters More Than Perfect Knowledge

“I am reminded of your sincere faith...” 2nd Timothy 1:5

Authenticity impacts people more than expertise.

People are watching how we live.

The world doesn't need a flawless faith. It needs a real faith.

That makes me think this stuff might actually be real.

3. God Loves Using Ordinary, Unfinished People

“God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong.”
1st Corinthians 1:26-27

Jesus called ordinary people.

God isn't looking for impressive people; He's looking for available people.

The miracle has never been the perfection of the vessel; the miracle is what God pours through it.

4. It is Okay to Say, "I Don't Know, Let's Learn Together"

“Get wisdom. Though it cost all you have, get understanding.”
Proverbs 4:7

Wisdom is a pursuit, not a destination.

Questions are not the enemy of faith.

People don't always need an expert. They need someone willing to stay in the conversation.

5. Remember Who the Saviour Is

“He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion...”
Philippians 1:6

We cannot save people.

Salvation belongs to God.

You're trying to be someone's saviour. And that role is already taken.

You are not the Saviour. Jesus is.

Takeaway: Keep opening your Bible. Keep praying.

Keep learning. Keep walking toward Jesus.

God has always used ordinary people who were still learning to point others to an extraordinary Saviour.

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
